WIDA Test Practice: Grades 1-12

The purpose of this document is to provide the steps needed to access the DRC Public Test Resources in preparation for the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 assessment. Families can access these tools to aid students in becoming familiar with and preparing for the online WIDA ACCESS assessment.

This intuitive, easy-to-use interface combines tutorials, online tools training, and practice tests. Utilizing this environment will minimize the training and practice time required for educators and students to become comfortable with online testing. It is recommended students log in to the Test Practice items prior to being exposed to the WIDA assessment.

1. Using Google Chrome, access the Public Test Resources using the following URL: https://wbte.drcedirect.com/WIDA/portals/wida



- 2. Select *Test Practice* under the *ACCESS for ELLs 2.0* icon.
- 3. Select Listening, Reading, Speaking or Writing, then select the desired grade band.



4. Use the provided credentials and select Sign In.

WIDA provides these practice items which are aligned to the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 so students may become familiar with the online testing environment. Additional items may be found under *Sample Items*, which are organized by tier and can provide students with the opportunity of viewing sample test content. Answers to the *Test Practice* are not found within the online content and the test ends upon completion of the last question in each test.
